### Make a Golf Course in your Back Garden!

### Equipment needed:

Variety of cardboard boxes or tubes  
A small ball  
A golf club (or use something you already have in the house)  
Coloured paper/pens to decorate

### How to do it?

1. Use the boxes / tubes that you have available to create "holes" for your golf course. **Remember to ask a parent for help if you're cutting.**
2. Don't forget to add numbers to your golf course holes. There are normally 18 holes on a standard golf course.
3. Decorate your creations to make them stand out!
4. Create a golf course around a room or in the garden and decide the target number of 'hits' for each one. (Some may be trickier than others)
5. Ask a family member to play along and don't forget to keep score.
